Open mornings

Suncream

We are going to be actively encouraging all children to wear a hat when they play outside. We have some

nursery hats for the use of children in Nursery 2 and 3 but children aged under 2yrs need to keep their own hats at nursery. We will encourage all children to cover up with lightweight, long sleeved tops when the sun index is moderate to high. Staff at nursery will be supervising children applying their own sun cream and helping those that are unable to apply sun cream by themselves. It is essential for parents to ensure they apply appropriate sun cream to their child before they come to nursery, to complete the sun cream permission form and provide a bottle of factor 15+ sun cream clearly labelled with their child's name, if sun cream is to be re-applied.
