

Directions to Trinity School, Teignmouth



Arriving in the UK by Air


Transferring from Heathrow: there are frequent trains into London Paddington.

Trains from London Paddington: Depending on the time of day, trains run about every half hour. The fastest trains from Paddington take just over two hours to reach Exeter; others go via Bristol. On most occasions you will need to change at Exeter, but some London trains do stop at Teignmouth.

Transferring from Gatwick: Gatwick Express trains run every 30 minutes, non-stop to London Victoria. Then catch a taxi or the tube (Circle Line) to Paddington.

Hiring a Car: approximate journey times to Teignmouth from:

- Heathrow via M4/M5: 3 hours 15 minutes (195 miles / 313km)
- Heathrow via A303: 3 hours 15 minutes (173 miles / 278km)
- Birmingham: 3 hours (180 miles / 290km)
- Gatwick via A303: 3 hours 45 minutes (195 miles / 315km)
- Gatwick via M4/M5: 4 hours (235 miles / 375km)
- Bristol: 1 hour 40 minutes (80 miles / 126km)



Arriving By Car (SatNav: postcode TQ14 8LY – see * below)

From Exeter:

- Continue from the end of the M5 onto the A38, bearing left at the bottom of Telegraph Hill onto the A380 to Torquay.
- After 5.9 miles (9.5km) take the B3192 towards Teignmouth.
- After 4.4 miles (7.1km), just after the cemetery on your left, turn left into New Road, then take the first right into Buckeridge Road.

From Dawlish:

- Follow the A379 towards Teignmouth.
- 2 miles from the centre of Dawlish, turn right into New Road.
- After 0.7 miles turn left into Buckeridge Road.

From Newton Abbot:

- Follow the A381 towards Teignmouth for 3.8 miles (6.1km).
- In the centre of Teignmouth turn left at traffic lights, following signs for Exeter.
- After 0.6 miles (950m) turn right into New Road as the hill levels out, then take the first right into Buckeridge Road.

From Torbay:

- From the end of the Riviera Way, follow the South Devon Express Way (A380) towards Exeter, past Kingskerswell and Newton Abbot.
- After 4.7 miles (7.6km) exit the dual carriageway and follow the A381 towards Teignmouth (continue as from Newton Abbot).

Trinity School is on your left. Drive down the hill, past the layby (* ignore the SatNav if it directs you into Farm Lane by the layby). The main entrance is 200m down the hill on your left. Turn back up the drive and park in the Visitors' space, with the White House on your right.

Arriving by Train

Although Trinity School is within walking distance of the station, it is advisable to take a taxi to avoid the steep hill. Please contact the Registrar (01626 771 530) for further information about taxis.
