Prep 5

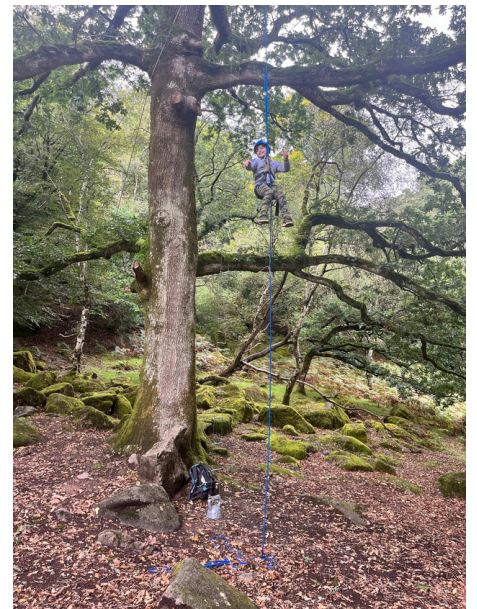

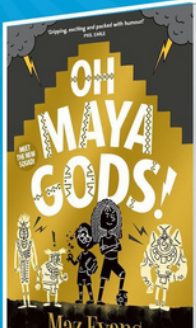
Scholastic Book Fair
